

Learning through play

September 2021 is an exciting time for all Reception settings, as there is a new framework for the teachers to follow. The new framework is to ensure that all children are learning through choosing experiences of their own choice and playing; it is in these playing activities the children will apply their knowledge and teachers will look for milestones in development.





Workshops

We want to support you every step of the way in understanding early years.



Traditionally in Autumn, we run workshops and courses to help support parents understand how we teach specific aspects of the curriculum; phonics, reading, writing and maths.

The school day, once the children are settled and understand routines:

- 8.40 – 9.00** **Registration/ handwriting**
- 9.00 - 9.20** **Phonics**
- 9.20 - 9.40** **Maths/English/Subject input**
- 9.40 - 10.30** **Choosing time**
- 10.30 - 10.50** **Maths/English/Subject input**
- 10.50 - 11.50** **Choosing time**
- 1.00 - 2.45** **Circle time and choosing time**
- 2.45 - 3.00** **Story time**

Frequently asked questions

- **How will it look in September with the current situation?**
 - Million dollar question! As soon as we know what we can do, we will be communicating that to you. We are making plans as if we will see you all in September however, we will keep you all posted of any changes. At the moment Reception parents come onto the school grounds and drop the children off at the classroom door
- **What PE kit do I need?**

Please don't worry, we don't change for PE until a few weeks in. We will allocate team colours after the first half term.
- **When will I know the class teacher?**

We run as a unit, so details we will be sent out in an email soon to tell you what group name your child will be in and the teachers name who will register and dismiss your child.
- **What else do I need?**
 - There may be things we will ask of you throughout the year, for example wellies, but we will email, text or send a letter out as and when we do.

Next steps

- Please complete the admission paperwork and return this to the school office (open between 9.30-2.30pm Monday-Friday; please can you wear a mask unless exempt and follow social distancing guidelines).
- You will also need to bring your child's original 'full version' of the birth certificate.
- Do not worry and get anxious as everyone is at the same starting point.
